Starting Times – Three Games Guaranteed

High School/Club Teams: **Teams do not have to be part of a club; any teams assembled are welcome.** On site check in starts at 9:00 AM. First games will start at 10:00 AM. First 16 teams registered and paid are guaranteed a spot in the tournament.

Rules and Regulations

Entry Fee: There is a \$150.00 registration fee which is non-refundable. Registration need to be in by 2/16/2020.

Registration: All players must be registered prior to the tournament on their respective team's roster. Additions cannot be made after the on-site check in. High School Student ID card required for registration the day of.

Team Size and Play: The maximum team size of ten players, with 5(Including goalkeeper) on the pitch at any one time. Players may only play on one team during this tournament.

Uniforms: All players must wear jersey/shirt while playing. Each member of the team must bring a light color shirt and a dark color shirt (same uniform color for all team members). If both teams are wearing the same color the home team (listed first) must change uniforms. However, during playoffs, the higher seated team decides. No jersey numbers are required. We will supply pinnies if needed.

Equipment: All players must wear shin guards. No athletic shoes with spikes will be allowed. All soccer balls will be supplied for the tournament. This tournament will be played with Fustal balls.

Field Characteristics: Fields will be sectioned off in the Kaukauna High School gym. The fields will be approximately 25 x 45 yards. Penalty box is the Basketball 3 point arc. Normal futsal goals will be used

Duration of Game: The game shall consist of 2x15-minute periods separated by a three-minute break. There are no timeouts. Games tied after regulation play will end in a tie except for playoff game.

Substitutions: May be made on the fly from the center check in area. A player may not enter the field until substituting player enters the check in area.

Scoring Goals: Normal soccer rules apply.

Point System: The games will be scored according to the following system – five points are awarded for a win. Three points are awarded for a tie and zero points are awarded for a loss. One point is awarded for a goal up to three points. One point for a shutout. A forfeit will be recorded as a 3-0 shutout (9 points).

Tie Breakers: For teams tied in record, if a team forfeited a game, they are on the lower seed. For teams where one team received a forfeit game against the team forfeited are counted when figuring the tiebreaker. In pool play, ties between three or more teams will be broken by: 1. Head to head results between tied teams; 2. Goal differences in head-to-head game; 3. Goals against in head-to-head games; 4. Goal differences in pool play; 5. Goals against in pool play; 6. Playoff team shoot out.

Ties between two teams will be broken by: 1. Head-to-head; 2. Goal differences in pool play; 3. Goals against in pool play; 4. Playoff team shoot out.

Overtime and Shoot Out (only in playoffs): One five-minute sudden death overtime period will be played with a coin toss to decide kickoff possession. The first team to score wins. If no team has scored in the five minute overtime period, the teams participate in a shoot out. A coin flip will decide which team starts. Five players from each team will take the penalty shots. The teams will alternate shots and the team with the higher score at the end of the round will win. If the score is tied, one player from each team will enter a sudden death shoot out where the teams will continue taking shots until one team scores an unanswered point, this being the winner.

Five-Foot Rule: In all dead ball situations, including kick-offs, defending players must stand at least five feet away from the ball.

If the defensive player's goal area is closer than five feet, the ball will be placed five feet from the goal area in line with the penalty.

Kick-Ins: When the ball leaves the field of play (in bleachers or past divider) the ball shall be kicked into play from the sideline in place of a throw-in. All dead balls (kick-ins, free kicks, kick-offs) are indirect with exception of corner and penalty kicks.

Penalty Kicks: Will be taken from the penalty spot marked on the pitch.

Indirect/Direct Kicks: Normal Soccer rules apply to fouls.

Red Cards: Referees have the right to eject a player from the game for continual disobedience or as a result of an incident that warrants a player off send off. The team may then continue with the remaining players. However, if the player was in the field of play, the team must complete the game one player down. The player receiving the red cards will not be allowed to play in any further games in the tournament. This is a tournament and sportsmanship is the highest concern. Foul language and fighting will not be tolerated and will be punished severely.

Forfeits: Any team forfeiting two consecutive games in pool play will be removed from the tournament. A team, at the discretion of the referee and the tournament director will be forfeited at game time if they are not present. Teams are responsible for waiting until seeding for playoffs has been determined.

Additional Issues: Problems arising from unclear rules will be solved with the sole discretion of the tournament director.
